#### **About the Event**

ICI- ACECON is an event organised once in 5 years in India to deal with salient issues relating to concrete and concrete structures. The last event was organised by ICI- Kolkata centre in Kolkata in the year 2015. ICI-ACECON 2020 is being organised by ICI New Delhi Centre on 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2020 in Delhi.

Keeping in view the recent challenges faced world over, the subject of the conference has been chosen to deal with sustainability issues. Blending of cement with Fly-ash, Blast Furnace Slag, etc. provides several advantages to concrete properties apart from managing the waste products and conserving natural resources. Among the other structures, Petronas Towers in Kuala Lumpur has employed the use of M80 concrete. For long lasting properties, Ultra High Performance Concrete (UHPC) becomes a must, especially in aggressive environments. In order to meet the demands of rising population, it becomes prudent to go for tall structures such as Burj Khalifa, Dubai. India is also constructing upto 80 storeyed buildings. A large number of 275m tall chimneys have been constructed in India and abroad to deal with pollution norms for thermal power plants. Millau Viaduct France, bridges of Jammu Udhampur Rail Link are some of the examples of tall bridges with the pier heights varying from 40m to 300m. Similarly, large spans become unavoidable in many circumstances. Reasons may be many, geotechnical aspects in case bridges, usage of column free area in case of buildings, etc. Akashi Kaikyo bridge in Japan, Kanteerava Stadium structure in Bangalore, India are some of the examples.

The organisers hope that the delegates carry some memorable experiences of the event.

Weather in September : Daily high temperatures are around 92°F, rarely falling below 86°F or exceeding 97°F.




